

This year, your support changed lives, from the Bronx to Staten Island.

In 2016, we provided individualized tutoring to foster youth who needed extra help to keep up with their education and stay on track for their future. Our Haven Academy scholars excelled in the classroom and beyond—outperforming students from across the city once again this year! In addition, last year, The Foundling developed a new program to support 40 foster youth residing on campus at Queens College and attending CUNY schools.

125 families experiencing hardship relied on our Crisis Nursery to keep their children safe and 1,200 parents received advice and referrals over the phone on our 24/7 Parent Helpline. Over 100 children in Foundling foster homes experienced the magic of Camp Felix and created memories there that will last a lifetime.

adoptions and 52 kinship guardianships.



Our Wonderful Donors

In 2016, **1,541 people** donated to The Foundling. Whether you mailed a check or donated online, attended one of our events, hosted your own diaper drive, or even purchased a cup of coffee at COFFEED, **YOU** helped make a difference!

Here are some of the unique ways our community gave back:

The Foundling's inaugural Superhero Campaign for Child Abuse Prevention took place in April. We gained 3,200 new social media followers for The Foundling and raised **\$6,000** for our Child Abuse Prevention Program through a match from a Foundling board member.

Fall Fête raised **half a million dollars** for the second year in a row! Board member and NY1 anchor Pat Kiernan hosted the festivities as we honored corporate citizen **BNY Mellon** for their support of our digital access program for youth in foster care.

WeWork hosted our annual Career Night for young people across Foundling programs at their headquarters, with an all-time of record **125 teens** in attendance! **Macy's** outfitted dorm rooms with bedding, bathroom accessories and other housewares for our very first class of college students in foster care living at Queens College.

The Blue Party entertained a sold-out crowd of 500 young professionals at the Bowery Hotel, and raised awareness of the issues children and teens in foster care face daily, along with **\$100,000** to help fund Foundling enrichment programs for the same youth!

Reflections Center for Conscious Living and Yoga hosted a holiday bazaar for their clients where they raised **\$1,000** in donations for The Foundling in one day!

The Foundling is focused on **strengthening families** in all their forms.

One of our primary goals, over the past 150 years and going forward, has been to directly confront the myriad challenges faced by the children and families we serve, and to offer creative and effective solutions that set them up for future success.

Here are a few ways you help us make **families stronger.**

Expanding our commitment to communities in the South Bronx.

This fall, we will welcome our first class of middle schoolers at The Foundling's Mott Haven Academy Charter School, a year earlier than anticipated. By working with these children for more of their childhood, we ensure continuity of education and care for our scholars and act as a stabilizing anchor for them and for their families, the majority of whom are involved in the child welfare system.

Teaching parents a better way.

Our Child Abuse Prevention Program already reaches 22,000 elementary school students each year, and teaches them to recognize, report and resist child abuse. Now, we've expanded this award-winning program to focus on the whole family by leading free and voluntary parenting classes to teach alternatives to using corporal punishment on children. We now have a waitlist for the program! There are lots of ways you can continue to be a partner in The Foundling's mission!

Keeping families together after trauma. The Foundling is a pioneer in Kinship Guardianship, also known as "kincare," which places children who have been removed from their biological parents in the care of a member of their extended family, often a grandparent or aunt/ uncle. Maintaining family bonds and keeping community ties strong has proven to be a highly effective way to minimize the stress and serious negative impacts a stay in foster care can have on a child.


