WHAT IS CAMP FELIX?

Camp Felix is a free summer sleep-away camp for children who are involved with The New York Foundling. At Camp Felix, children engage in a variety of fun summer activities within a structured and safe environment.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

To be eligible, children must be:

- Current or prior clients of The New York Foundling.
- 8 to 13 years of age (14- and 15-yearolds can attend if they are returning campers).

WHEN IS CAMP FELIX?

There are four one-week sessions during the summer of 2018 (Monday—Friday only). Campers may attend a maximum of two sessions.

Session 1: July 30-August 3, 2018 Session 2: August 6-10, 2018 Session 3: August 13-17, 2018 Session 4: August 20-24, 2018

Why Send Kids to Camp?

At camp, kids have the opportunity to make new friends, improve their self-esteem, overcome challenges, develop healthy habits, and learn skills that will help them succeed throughout their lives.

HOW TO APPLY

- Speak with your case planner to receive instructions on completing the camper application online.
- Schedule a doctor's appointment for your child(ren) to get the necessary medical forms completed.
- · Complete the online application.

Completed applications are due by June 1, 2018.
