

WHAT IS CAMP FELIX AT HOME?

WHEN IS CAMP FELIX AT HOME?

Camp Felix At Home will run from August 3 through August 28, 2020, providing approximately up to 3 hours of daily virtual activities Monday through Friday. Each day will include a break for lunch in the afternoon.

HOW TO APPLY

Speak with your case planner to receive instructions on completing the camper application, which can be done entirely online.

CHECKLIST AND NEXT STEPS

- Work with your case planner to complete the entire application by July 13, 2020.
- Maintain communication with your case planner about any changes prior to the camp start date of August 3.
- Make sure Camp Felix staff have your current phone number and email address.
- Check email regularly for Camp Felix At Home instructions, notifications, and information.

Requirements and Process

To participate, children will need a computer or tablet with a reliable Internet connection. For families that do not have this at home, Camp Felix will provide all necessary technology.

Children must have an adult within earshot for supervision purposes.

Each week, a schedule with Zoom links and codes will be sent to campers. Campers will be able to access these links and join virtual camp activities as they choose.

Any supplies for camp activities will be mailed to campers' homes in advance.
