Healthy Families Program

A home visiting program supporting new and expectant parents in Staten Island

In operation in Staten Island for more than a decade, The Foundling's Healthy Families program is a free home visiting program designed to help parents meet the challenges of parenting and ensure the healthy development of their children.

Being a new parent can be stressful and overwhelming, and many families, particularly those who are socially or geographically isolated, struggle to provide a supportive environment for their children. The Healthy Families program promotes child and family health, development, and self-sufficiency through home visiting services that support parents from pregnancy until their child is ready for school. The program is designed to help prevent child abuse and neglect by promoting positive parenting skills and parent-child interaction. Participants are also connected to community resources that help to strengthen their families and promote well-baby care.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be pregnant or have an infant less than 3 months old
- Must live in one of the following Staten Island zip codes:
 - 10301
 - 10302
 - 10303
 - 10304
 - 10310



THE PROCESS

- A Family Resource Specialist will meet with the family to do a complete assessment of the family's needs and stressors
- The family will receive free weekly home visits that will address a variety of relevant topics - serving the family from pregnancy to toddler age
