DAY HABILITATION WITHOUT WALLS

Available in New York City & Rockland County

Day Habilitation Without Walls offers participants the ability to integrate into their local community through various daily planned events. These person-centered activities are based on the wants and needs of the individual and their family. Participants develop social, interpersonal, communication, work and problem solving skills.

The program features a 1:4 staffing ratio, and curbside pickup and drop-off is available for participants.

Highlights include:

- Educational Classes
- External Music Classes
- Art Therapy Programs
- Community Recreational Activities (bowling, parks, movies, etc.)
- Cooking Classes
- Assistive Technology
- Sports & Exercise
- Connection to our Employment Services program, which provides job training, work experience, and paid employment
