CATALYST AWARD

William Sinclair is the **New York Region Head and Global Co-Head of the Family Office Practice at J.P. Dr. Maksoud is deeply passionate about advocacy for direct support professionals (DSPs) and healthcare workers, recognizing their essential role in delivering compassionate, high-quality care. He is equally committed to advancing services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, ensuring they receive the dignity, access, and support they deserve.

In addition to his work at CCRx, Dr. Maksoud is the founder of Dawah Pharma, a platform focused on manufacturing high-quality affordable sterile medications to address critical gaps in care. He earned his Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy from St. John's University and continues to lead with a vision centered on innovation, equity, and community impact.
